

PROJECT SPECIAL PROVISIONS
Utility Construction

Revise the 2012 *Standard Specifications* as follows:

Utility Owners' Contact Information:

Page 15-1, Subarticle 1500-2 Cooperation with the Utility Owner, paragraph 2, add the following sentences:

Tyrell County is owner of the water facilities. The Contractor must contact owner 48 hours in advance of construction and 48 hours in advance of a tie-in. The contact person is Johnny Spencer (252-796-1371).

The Contractor shall provide access for the owner's representatives during construction and provide a set of as-built plans to Tyrell County after all work shown on the Utility Construction Plan is completed.

Page 15-6, 1510-3(B) Subarticle Construction Methods, after line 21, replace the allowable leakage formula with the following:

$$W=LD(\sqrt{P})\div 148,000$$

Page 15-6, 1510-3(B) Subarticle Construction Methods, line 32, delete "concurrently or".

Page 15-9, Subarticle 1515-2 Materials, add the following sentences:

The proposed utility construction shall meet the applicable requirements (i.e. material specifications, standard details, testing, policies, etc.) of the NCDOT's "Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures" (dated January, 2012). Measurement and payment for work will be in accordance with NCDOT's "Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures" (dated January, 2012).
