

MANAGEMENT STRATEGIES

- CLOSE SR 1001 (HALLSBORO RD) AND DETOUR TRAFFIC OFF-SITE
- LOCAL ACCESS TO ALL RESIDENCES AND BUSINESSES WILL BE MAINTAINED BETWEEN CLOSURE POINTS AT ALL TIMES DURING CONSTRUCTION
- PROVIDE ONE MONTH NOTICE TO THE ENGINEER, BLADEN AND COLUMBUS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES, AND BLADEN AND COLUMBUS COUNTY SCHOOL OFFICIALS PRIOR TO ROAD CLOSURE

GENERAL NOTES

CHANGES MAY BE REQUIRED WHEN PHYSICAL DIMENSIONS IN THE DETAIL DRAWINGS, STANDARD DETAILS, AND ROADWAY DETAILS ARE NOT ATTAINABLE TO MEET FIELD CONDITIONS OR RESULT IN DUPLICATE OR UNDESIRED OVERLAPPING OF DEVICES. MODIFICATION MAY INCLUDE: MOVING, SUPPLEMENTING, COVERING, OR REMOVAL OF DEVICES AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.

THE FOLLOWING GENERAL NOTES APPLY AT ALL TIMES FOR THE DURATION OF THE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT EXCEPT WHEN OTHERWISE NOTED IN THE PLAN OR DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.

TRAFFIC PATTERN ALTERATIONS

A) NOTIFY THE ENGINEER ONE MONTH PRIOR TO ANY TRAFFIC PATTERN ALTERATION.

B) PROVIDE SIGNING AND DEVICES REQUIRED TO CLOSE THE ROAD ACCORDING TO THE ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWINGS AND TRAFFIC CONTROL PLANS.

PROVIDE SIGNING REQUIRED FOR THE OFF-SITE DETOUR ROUTE.

C) COVER OR REMOVE ALL SIGNS AND DEVICES REQUIRED TO CLOSE THE ROAD WHEN ROAD CLOSURE IS NOT IN OPERATION.

COVER OR REMOVE ALL SIGNS REQUIRED FOR THE OFF-SITE DETOUR WHEN THE DETOUR IS NOT IN OPERATION.


D) ENSURE ALL NECESSARY SIGNING IS IN PLACE PRIOR TO ALTERING ANY TRAFFIC PATTERN.

E) PLACE TYPE III BARRICADES WITH "ROAD CLOSED" SIGN R11-2 ATTACHED, OF SUFFICIENT LENGTH TO CLOSE ENTIRE ROADWAY.


PHASING


- STEP 1: USING RSD 1101.03 SHEET 1 OF 9, CLOSE HALLSBORO ROAD (SR 1001) AND DETOUR TRAFFIC OFF-SITE AS SHOWN ON TMP-2.
 MAINTAIN ACCESS TO ALL RESIDENCES AND BUSINESSES BETWEEN CLOSURE POINTS.
- STEP 2: REMOVE THE EXISTING STRUCTURE.
- STEP 3: CONSTRUCT THE PROPOSED STRUCTURE AND ROADWAY.
- STEP 4: PLACE FINAL PAVEMENT MARKINGS ACCORDING TO THE PAVEMENT MARKING PLANS.
- STEP 5: OPEN HALLSBORO ROAD (SR 1001) TO TRAFFIC AND REMOVE ALL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES.
