



GUIDANCE DETAIL FOR STANDARD AND HI-VISIBILTY CROSSWALKS AT SIGNALIZED OR STOP SIGN CONTROLLED INTERSECTIONS

NOTES:

- 1. USE DETAILS ABOVE AND THE FOLLOWING NOTES FOR GUIDANCE IN PLACING CROSSWALKS AND STOP BARS NOT STATIONED ON THE DETAIL SHEETS OR WHEN FIELD ADJUSTMENTS REQUIRED MOVING STATIONED MARKINGS AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER. REFER TO NCDOT ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWINGS, MUTCD AND ADA STANDARDS FOR ADDITIONAL GUIDANCE.
- 2. SET BACK DISTANCE FROM INSIDE CROSSWALK MARKING TO NEAREST EDGE OF TRAVEL IS 4' MIN.
- 3. BEYOND THE BOTTOM GRADE BRAKE, A CLEAR SPACE OF 4' X 4' MINIMUM SHALL BE PROVIDED WITHIN THE WIDTH OF THE CROSSWALK.
- 4. SINGLE DIAGONAL CURB RAMPS WITH FLARED SIDES SHALL HAVE A SEGMENT OF CURB 2 FEET LONG MINIMUM LOCATED ON EACH SIDE OF THE CURB RAMP AND WITHIN THE MARKED CROSSING, SEE DETAIL 'B'.
- 5. CURB RAMPS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE TO THE LATEST NCDOT ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWINGS.
