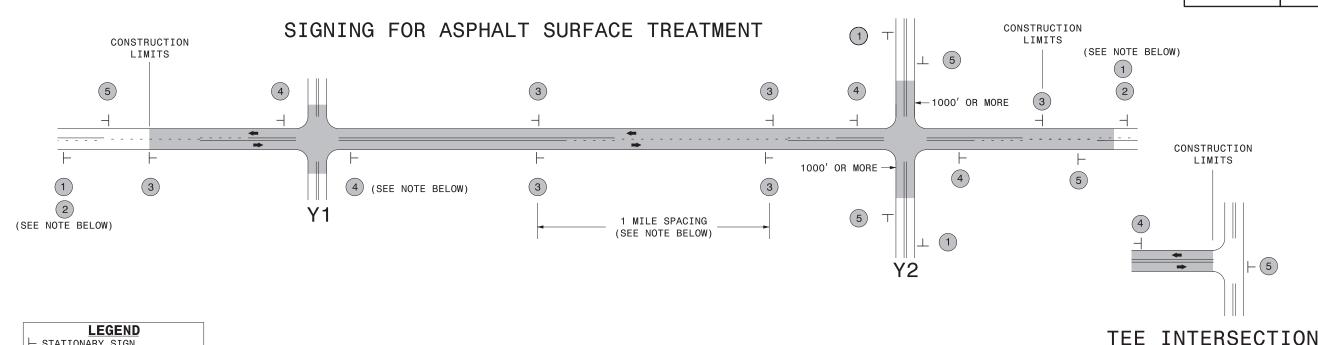

MAINLINE (-L-) SIGNING

NO REQUIRED STATIONARY SIGNING FOR THE FOLLOWING -Y- LINE CONDITIONS:

1) LESS THAN 1000' OF RESURFACING ALONG -Y- LINE

-Y- LINE SIGNING

- 2) SUBDIVISION ROADS
- 3) DEAD END ROADS

WHEN PAVING/CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES PROCEED ACROSS AN UNSIGNED -Y- LINE, ADVANCE WARNING PORTABLE SIGNS SHALL BE USED ALONG THE -Y- LINE AS SHOWN BELOW. REMOVE UPON COMPLETION OF WORK.





PLACED 500' IN ADVANCE OF FLAGGER. PLACED 250' IN ADVANCE OF FLAGGER.

PLACE 1000' PRIOR TO BEGINNING OF CONSTRUCTION LIMITS. ROAD ONLY USED ON -Y- LINES IF RESURFACING LIMITS EXTEND 1000' ALONG -Y- LINE. WORK AHEAD / W20-1 #2 SIGN ONLY USED WHEN RESURFACING LIMITS ARE 2 OR MORE MILES IN LENGTH. ES AND DIRECTION ROUND UP TO NEXT WHOLE NUMBER. (NO FRACTIONAL OR DECIMAL NUMBERS) (LOOSE - ALTERNATE THE FOLLOWING TWO SIGNS: (3) GRAVEL - STARTING WITH "LOOSE GRAVEL" (W8-7) FOLLOWED BY "UNMARKED PAVEMENT". NOTE ER [- PLACE INITIALLY AT THE CONSTRUCTION LIMITS AND SPACED 1 MILE APART THEREAFTER. UNMARKED - AT TEE INTERSECTIONS INSTALL INITIALLY 0.5 MILE FROM INTERSECTION SIGNING PLACEMENT P PAVEMENT . AND SPACE 1 MILE APART THEREAFTER. SP 48" X 48" - THESE ARE FOR -Y- LINES THAT ARE "THROUGH" ROADWAYS. - DEAD END AND SUBDIVISION ROADS ARE NOT "THROUGH" ROADWAYS. ROAD - INSTALL 500' +/- FROM EACH -Y- LINE APPROACH AS SHOWN ABOVE. UNDER - FOR MULTIPLE -Y- LINES THAT ARE SEPARATED BY 0.25 MILES OR LESS, CONST TREAT AS A SINGLE UNIT AND INSTALL WITHIN 500' OF EACH APPROACH. - A MAXIMUM OF 2 SIGN SETS PER MILE. DO NOT INSTALL WHEN -Y- LINES ARE WITHIN 0.5 MILES FROM "END ROAD WORK" SIGN. - FOR TEE INTERSECTIONS, INSTALL WITHIN 500' +/- OF THE INTERSECTION ALONG -L- LINE. FND PLACE 500' FOLLOWING THE END OF CONSTRUCTION LIMITS OR AS SHOWN ROAD WORK WHEN WORK ENDS AT A 3-WAY TEE INTERSECTION. G20-2 A
