Provide appropriate lighting in accordance with Section 1413 of the 2018 Standard Specifications. Appropriate lighting shall be determined by the Engineer over the project. For safety precautions, the Engineer, at any time, can increase the number of lights on a project. The Contractor shall provide, install and maintain same as directed by the Engineer. Payment will be made as Extra Work in accordance with Article 104-7 of the Standard Specifications.

Mainline pavement shall not be left milled, unmarked or uneven at the end of a paving season. If the Contractor begins any map and does not complete within the seasonal restrictions, including placement of final pavement markings or permanent markers, the Contractor shall be responsible for, at his expense, Paint in accordance with Article 1205-08 and Temporary Markers in accordance with Section 1251 of the 2018 Standard Specifications.
