# Mitchell Bishop:

- ICTs
- Endangered plants, and the importance of delineation
- Delineation, and protection of Duke transmission Towers was discussed
- Terrain, obvious slope failure locations within the project area, and the grade of the pipe
- Borings for information to bid boring and jacking pipes
- Pipe beyond shoulder point will not have to be bedded with screenings, local material will be utilized, just not rocks that could damage pipe
- Brush and stumps must be removed from the project, stumps that are not excavated in the pipe laying process may remain in place
- Dave McHenry will clarify restrictions at outlet of pipes to be lines near the road due to endangered plants, and will be revised on plans
- TGS is to restake the final alignment of the pipe, as well as the clearing limits on PS09.
- As per Dave McHenry, a pre-clearing meeting is required two weeks prior to clearing. Also all equipment must be pressure washed before being unloaded at project

### TGS:

- Some pipe on I-26 is up to 17 feet deep with considerable groundwater
- As identified in the Special Provision, the lining of 42" diameter, (long pipe under I-26 and Howard Gap Road) was discussed. This will be a solid wall slip liner.
