

MAINLINE (-L-) SIGNING


ROAD WORK

-Y- LINE SIGNING




PLACE 500' FOLLOWING THE END OF CONSTRUCTION LIMITS OR AS SHOWN

WHEN WORK ENDS AT A 3-WAY TEE INTERSECTION.

THE ABOVE SIGNS ARE ALL THAT ARE REQUIRED FOR A CONTRACTOR TO BEGIN A RESURFACING CONTRACT. ANY ADDITIONAL SIGNS REQUESTED BY NCDOT DIVISIONS SHALL BE INSTALLED WITHIN 7 BUSINESS DAYS OF THE

FOR RESURFACING MAPS WITH CONSTRUCTION LIMITS LESS THAN 2 MILES IN LENGTH, NO STATIONARY SIGNS

ARE REQUIRED. USE PORTABLE "ROAD UNDER CONSTRUCTION" OR "ROAD WORK AHEAD" SIGNS IN LIEU OF
