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
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




LOCATION: BRIDGE NO. 7 OVER INDIAN CREEK ON NC 182



-CLOSE NC-182 AND DETOUR TRAFFIC OFF-SITE

-MAINTAIN LOCAL ACCESS TO ALL RESIDENCES AND BUSINESSES
BETWEEN CLOSURE POINTS AT ALL TIMES DURING CONSTRUCTION

GENERAL NOTES

CHANGES MAY BE REQUIRED WHEN PHYSICAL DIMENSIONS IN THE DETAIL DRAWINGS, STANDARD DETAILS, AND ROADWAY DETAILS ARE NOT ATTAINABLE TO MEET FIELD CONDITIONS OR RESULT IN DUPLICATE OR UNDESIRED OVERLAPPING OF DEVICES. MODIFICATION MAY INCLUDE: MOVING, SUPPLEMENTING, COVERING, OR REMOVAL OF DEVICES AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.

THE FOLLOWING GENERAL NOTES APPLY AT ALL TIMES FOR THE DURATION OF THE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT EXCEPT WHEN OTHERWISE NOTED IN THE PLAN OR DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.

A) NOTIFY THE ENGINEER THIRTY (30) CALENDAR DAYS PRIOR TO ANY TRAFFIC PATTERN ALTERATIONS.

B) PROVIDE SIGNING AND DEVICES REQUIRED TO CLOSE THE ROAD ACCORDING TO THE ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWINGS AND TRAFFIC CONTROL PLANS.

PROVIDE SIGNING REQUIRED FOR THE OFF-SITE DETOUR ROUTE AS SHOWN IN THE TRAFFIC CONTROL PLANS.

C) COVER OR REMOVE ALL SIGNS AND DEVICES REQUIRED TO CLOSE THE ROAD WHEN ROAD CLOSURE IS NOT IN OPERATION.

COVER OR REMOVE ALL SIGNS REQUIRED FOR THE OFF-SITE DETOUR WHEN THE DETOUR IS NOT IN OPERATION.

D) ENSURE ALL NECESSARY SIGNING IS IN PLACE PRIOR TO ALTERING ANY TRAFFIC PATTERN.

E) PLACE TYPE III BARRICADES, WITH "ROAD CLOSED" SIGN R11-2 ATTACHED, OF SUFFICIENT LENGTH TO CLOSE ENTIRE ROADWAY.

PHASING

STEP 1)

USING ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWING 1101.03, SHEET 1 OF 9, AND TMP-3, CLOSE NC-182 AND DETOUR TRAFFIC OFF-SITE AS SHOWN ON TMP-2 and TMP-3. MAINTAIN ACCESS TO ALL RESIDENCES AND BUSINESSES BETWEEN CLOSURE POINTS.


STEP 2)

WITH NC-182 CLOSED TO TRAFFIC, PERFORM THE FOLLOWING:

- -REMOVE EXISTING BRIDGE.
- -CONSTRUCT PROPOSED BRIDGE.
- -CONSTRUCT PROPOSED ROADWAY THROUGH TO THE FINAL SURFACE COURSE.
- -PLACE FINAL PAVEMENT MARKINGS AND TIE TO EXISTING MARKINGS.


STEP 3)

REMOVE ROAD CLOSURE DEVICES AND DETOUR SIGNS, AND OPEN NC-182 TO TRAFFIC.


