The Contractor shall complete the required work of installing, maintaining and removing the traffic control devices for road closures and restoring traffic to the existing traffic pattern. **Except as allowed by Intermediate Contract Time Number 4**, the Contractor shall not close **Any Ramp and/or Loop associated with I-40** during the following time restrictions:

DAY AND TIME RESTRICTIONS

Monday thru Sunday, 5:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M.

The time of availability for this intermediate contract time will be the time the Contractor begins to install traffic control devices required for road closures according to the time restrictions stated herein.

The completion time for this intermediate contract time will be the time the Contractor is required to complete the removal of traffic control devices required for the road closures according to the time restrictions stated herein and restore traffic to the existing traffic pattern

Scarification of bridge decks shall not be permitted during nightly ramp and/or loop closures, unless approved by the Engineer.

The liquidated damages are **Five Hundred Dollars (\$ 500.00)** per fifteen (15) minute time period.

The Contractor shall complete **any operations, as elected by the Contractor**, required of **Map #3 (Wade Avenue Ramp B)** and shall place and maintain traffic on same.

The work shall be completed over **four (4) consecutive weekends of the Contractor's choosing, beginning at 9:00 P.M. on a Friday, and ending at 6:00 A.M. the following Monday for each weekend. The closure of Map #3 shall have an offsite detour approved by the Engineer.**

The date of availability for this intermediate contract time is the date which is the **Friday at 9:00 P.M. of the first weekend** the Contractor elects to begin the work.

The completion date for this intermediate contract time is the date which is the **Monday at 6:00 A.M. of the fourth weekend** after the Contractor begins the work of this intermediate contract time.

The liquidated damages are **Five Hundred Dollars (\$ 500.00)** per fifteen (15) minute time period. **The Holiday and Holiday Weekend Lane Closure Restrictions described in Intermediate Contract Time Number 1 shall apply to this work.**
