



# LOCATION: I-40 OVER HOMINY CREEK, HOMINY CREEK RD AND FRENCH BROAD RIVER







## **MANAGEMENT STRATEGIES**

THE INTENT OF THIS PLAN IS TO PERFORM BRIDGE DECK AND APPROACH ROADWAY WORK ACTIVITIES DURING PERIODS OF ROAD CLOSURE, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO FINE MILLING, DECK SCARIFICATION, HYDRO-DEMOLITION, LMC-VES DECK OVERLAY, BRIDGE EXPANSION JOINTS AND APPROACH RESURFACING.

NIGHTLY LANE CLOSURES ARE PROVIDED TO SUPPORT SUBSTRUCTURE REPAIR ACTIVITIES, INCLUDING WORKER INGRESS/EGRESS AND MATERIAL HANDLING.

ALL GUARDRAIL, INCLUDING BRIDGE MOUNTED THRIE BEAM GUARDRAIL, SHALL BE IN PLACE AND TRAFFIC READY PRIOR TO THE END OF ANY WEEKEND OR LANE CLOSURE PERIOD.

ALL SUBSTRUCTURE REPAIR WORK FOR THE SPANS AND BENTS ADJACENT TO THE FRENCH BROAD RIVER GREENWAY AND BILTMORE FARM TRAIL SHALL BE PERFORMED DURING TEMPORARY NIGHTLY CLOSURE PERIODS. PRIOR TO RETURNING TO NORMAL TRAFFIC, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ENSURE THE CONDITION OF THE BRIDGE SPANS AND ADJACENT BENTS TO ALLOW SAFE USE OF THE GREENWAY AND FARM TRAIL.



- D) REMOVE LANE CLOSURE DEVICES FROM THE LANE WHEN WORK IS NOT BEING PERFORMED BEHIND THE LANE CLOSURE OR WHEN A LANE CLOSURE IS NO LONGER NEEDED OR AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.
- E) WHEN PERSONNEL AND/OR EQUIPMENT ARE WORKING WITHIN 15 FT OF AN OPEN TRAVEL LANE, CLOSE THE NEAREST OPEN SHOULDER USING ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWING NO. 1101.04 UNLESS THE WORK AREA IS PROTECTED BY BARRIER OR GUARDRAIL OR A LANE CLOSURE IS INSTALLED.
- F) WHEN PERSONNEL AND/OR EQUIPMENT ARE WORKING ON THE SHOULDER ADJACENT TO AN UNDIVIDED FACILITY AND WITHIN 5 FT OF AN OPEN TRAVEL LANE, CLOSE THE NEAREST OPEN TRAVEL LANE USING ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWING NO. 1101.02 UNLESS THE WORK AREA IS PROTECTED BY BARRIER OR GUARDRAIL.

WHEN PERSONNEL AND/OR EQUIPMENT ARE WORKING ON THE SHOULDER ADJACENT TO A DIVIDED FACILITY AND WITHIN 10 FT OF AN OPEN TRAVEL LANE, CLOSE THE NEAREST OPEN TRAVEL LANE USING ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWING NO. 1101.02 UNLESS THE WORK AREA IS PROTECTED BY BARRIER OR GUARDRAIL.

- WHEN PERSONNEL AND/OR EQUIPMENT ARE WORKING WITHIN A LANE OF TRAVEL
  OF AN UNDIVIDED OR DIVIDED FACILITY, CLOSE THE LANE ACCORDING TO
  THE TRAFFIC CONTROL PLANS, ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWINGS, OR AS DIRECTED
  BY THE ENGINEER. CONDUCT THE WORK SO THAT ALL PERSONNEL AND/OR

PAVEMENT EDGE DROP OFF REQUIREMENTS

I) BACKFILL AT A 6:1 SLOPE UP TO THE EDGE AND ELEVATION OF EXISTING PAVEMENT IN AREAS ADJACENT TO AN OPENED TRAVEL LANE THAT HAS AN EDGE OF PAVEMENT DROP-OFF AS FOLLOWS:

BACKFILL DROP-OFFS THAT EXCEED 2 INCHES ON ROADWAYS WITH POSTED SPEED LIMITS OF 45 MPH OR GREATER.

BACKFILL DROP-OFFS THAT EXCEED 3 INCHES ON ROADWAYS WITH POSTED SPEED LIMITS LESS THAN 45 MPH.

BACKFILL WITH SUITABLE COMPACTED MATERIAL, AS APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER, AT NO EXPENSE TO THE DEPARTMENT.

DO NOT EXCEED A DIFFERENCE OF 2 INCHES IN ELEVATION BETWEEN OPEN LANES OF TRAFFIC FOR NOMINAL LIFTS OF 1.5 INCHES.

INSTALL ADVANCE WARNING "UNEVEN LANES" SIGNS (W8-11) IN ADVANCE AND A MINIMUM OF EVERY HALF MILE THROUGHOUT THE UNEVEN AREA.

#### TRAFFIC PATTERN ALTERATIONS

K) NOTIFY THE ENGINEER THIRTY (30) CALENDAR DAYS PRIOR TO ANY TRAFFIC PATTERN ALTERATION.

#### SIGNING

- L) INSTALL ADVANCE WORK ZONE WARNING SIGNS WHEN WORK IS WITHIN 40 FT FROM THE EDGE OF TRAVEL LANE AND NO MORE THAN THREE (3) DAYS PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF CONSTRUCTION.
- M) PROVIDE SIGNING AND DEVICES REQUIRED TO CLOSE THE ROAD ACCORDING TO THE ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWINGS AND TRAFFIC CONTROL PLANS.

PROVIDE SIGNING REQUIRED FOR THE OFF-SITE DETOUR ROUTE AS SHOWN IN THE TRAFFIC CONTROL PLANS.

N) COVER OR REMOVE ALL SIGNS AND DEVICES REQUIRED TO CLOSE THE ROAD WHEN ROAD CLOSURE IS NOT IN OPERATION.

COVER OR REMOVE ALL SIGNS REQUIRED FOR THE OFF-SITE DETOUR WHEN THE DETOUR IS NOT IN OPERATION.

- O) ENSURE ALL NECESSARY SIGNING IS IN PLACE PRIOR TO ALTERING ANY TRAFFIC PATTERN.
- P) INSTALL BLACK ON ORANGE "DIP" SIGNS (W8-2) AND/OR "BUMP" SIGNS (W8-1) IN ADVANCE OF THE UNEVEN AREA, OR AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.

#### TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES

- Q) WHEN LANE CLOSURES ARE NOT IN EFFECT SPACE CHANNELIZING DEVICES IN WORK AREAS NO GREATER IN FEET THAN TWICE THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT (MPH) EXCEPT, 10 FT ON-CENTER IN RADII, AND 3 FT OFF THE EDGE OF AN OPEN TRAVELWAY. REFER TO STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR ROADS AND STRUCTURES SECTIONS 1130 (DRUMS), 1135 (CONES) AND 1180 (SKINNY DRUMS) FOR ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS.
- R) PLACE TYPE III BARRICADES, WITH "ROAD CLOSED" SIGN R11-2 ATTACHED OF SUFFICIENT LENGTH TO CLOSE ENTIRE ROADWAY.

#### PAVEMENT MARKINGS AND MARKERS

- S) PLACE ONE APPLICATION OF PAINT FOR TEMPORARY TRAFFIC PATTERNS.
  PLACE A SECOND APPLICATION OF PAINT SIX (6) MONTHS AFTER THE
  INITIAL APPLICATION AND EVERY SIX MONTHS AS DIRECTED BY THE
  ENGINEER.
- T) TIE PROPOSED PAVEMENT MARKING LINES TO EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKING LINES.
- U) REMOVE/REPLACE ANY CONFLICTING/DAMAGED PAVEMENT MARKINGS AND MARKERS BY THE END OF EACH DAY'S OPERATION.



- W) IN THE EVENT A TIE-IN CANNOT BE MADE IN ONE DAY'S TIME, BRING THE TIE-IN AREA TO AN APPROPRIATE ROADWAY ELEVATION AS DETERMINED BY THE ENGINEER. PLACE BLACK ON ORANGE "LOOSE GRAVEL" SIGNS (W8-7) AND BLACK ON ORANGE "PAVEMENT ENDS" SIGNS (W8-3) AND RESPECTIVELY IN ADVANCE OF THE UNEVEN AREAS. USE EXISTING DMS SIGN AND CHANGEABLE MESSAGE SIGNS TO ALERT THRU TRAFFIC OF DETOUR ROUTE ALONG I-240 WESTBOUND. SEE SHEET TMP-4 FOR MORE DETAILS.

CLOSE I-40 WESTBOUND AT US 25 INTERCHANGE USING ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWING 1101.03 SHEET 7 OF 9.

USE CHANGEABLE MESSAGE SIGNS FOR NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND US 25 TO ALERT TRAFFIC OF DETOUR ROUTE ALONG I-40 EASTBOUND TO I-240 WESTBOUND. SEE SHEET TMP-6 FOR MORE DETAILS.

USE CHANGEABLE MESSAGE SIGNS FOR NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND NC 191 TO ALERT TRAFFIC OF DETOUR ROUTE ALONG I-240 WESTBOUND. SEE SHEET TMP-7 FOR MORE DETAILS.

PERFORM BRIDGE DECK AND APPROACH ROADWAY WORK TO BRIDGES 100339, 100347 AND 100356. WHEN HYDRO-DEMOLITION IS INITIATED ON A BRIDGE DECK, COMPLETE THE REMAINING DECK WORK REQUIRED TO PROVIDE THE FINAL RIDING SURFACE PRIOR TO RETURNING THE BRIDGE TO NORMAL TRAFFIC, INCLUDING LMC-VES OVERLAY, APPROACH ROADWAY RESURFACING AND PAVEMENT MARKINGS. 


NC 191 NB TO I-40 WB DETOUR ROUTE





