

## RESOLUTION FOR BILL G. ANDERSON

WHEREAS, Bill G. Anderson was born in 1934 in Wilkes County, North Carolina, and has been a citizen and resident of Wilkes County for his entire life. He graduated from Wilkesboro High School in 1952 and received an Honorable Discharge from the U.S. Army, Army Security Agency, for which he served from 1954 to 1957; and

WHEREAS, Bill G. Anderson served in a number of capacities for the Administration of Governor Jim Holshouser between 1973 and 1977, including the Governor Holshouser Inaugural Commission in 1973 and Governor Holshouser's Law and Order Committee from 1973 to 1976; and

WHEREAS, Bill G. Anderson was a Special Investigator with the Wilkes County Sheriff's Office from 1971 to 1973 and was elected Sheriff to Wilkes County from 1974 to 1978; and

WHEREAS, Bill G. Anderson was appointed by the House of Representatives to the Criminal Justice Commission from 2005 to 2006; and

WHEREAS, Bill G. Anderson has been an active member of his community throughout his life, having served as President of Little League and Coach from 1958 to 1969, as Wilkes County Outstanding Man of the Year in 1966, and in a number of other capacities. He is also a life member of Cub Creek Baptist Church and served as Sunday School Director from 1960 to 1970; and

WHEREAS, the Wilkes County Commissioners desire to honor the life and achievements of Bill G. Anderson and express the appreciation of the County and its citizens for the service he has rendered his community, state and nation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation name a section of NC 16 in Wilkes County, from 0.2 mile north of the Wilkes-Alexander County line to near the NC 16-18/Country Club Road intersection as the ***Bill G. Anderson Highway***.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.
