

## RESOLUTION FOR CONRAD "BUCK" PAYSOUR JR.

WHEREAS, Conrad "Buck" Paysour Jr. was a native of Lincoln County, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Conrad "Buck" Paysour Jr. was only 13 when he began writing sports articles and taking photographs for the *Evening Herald* in Rock Hill, South Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Conrad "Buck" Paysour Jr. was a graduate of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill; and

WHEREAS, Conrad "Buck" Paysour Jr. was a writer for the *Greensboro News and Record*; and

WHEREAS, Conrad "Buck" Paysour Jr. was an avid fisherman who wrote several books describing his fishing experiences in Hyde County, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Conrad "Buck" Paysour Jr. died in June 2001 at the age of 69; and

WHEREAS, following his request, Conrad "Buck" Paysour Jr. was cremated and his ashes spread over Scranton Creek in Hyde County; and


WHEREAS, the Hyde County Board of Commissioners requested the North Carolina Department of Transportation honor Conrad "Buck" Paysour Jr.

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation names the bridge over Scranton Creek on U.S. 264 in Hyde County the *Buck Paysour Memorial Bridge* in memory of this North Carolina writer whose fishing experiences have been instrumental in promoting Hyde County and North Carolina as a place where anglers can find some of the best fishing anywhere.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.
