

RESOLUTION FOR C.B. "CHARLIE" GRIFFIN JR.

WHEREAS, C.B. "Charlie" Griffin Jr. was a strong community leader; and

WHEREAS, C.B. "Charlie" Griffin Jr. was a friend to all citizens regardless of race or religion; and

WHEREAS, C.B. "Charlie" Griffin Jr. was a chemical engineer, farmer, businessman, supporter of local investors and tobacco warehouse operator; and

WHEREAS, C.B. "Charlie" Griffin Jr. encouraged young people to pursue higher education; and

WHEREAS, C.B. "Charlie" Griffin Jr. was actively involved in economic development and Grace Episcopal Church; and

WHEREAS, the Bertie County Commissioners requested the N.C. Board of Transportation honor C.B. "Charlie" Griffin Jr.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation names N.C. 11 from the Bertie/Martin County line at the Roanoke River Bridge to north of the Lewiston/Woodville City Limits the C.B. "Charlie" Griffin Jr. Memorial Highway for his dedication to the citizens of his community.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.
