

A RESOLUTION FOR CADET WILLIAM E. BAYLESS, III

WHEREAS, Cadet William E. Bayless, III was born and reared in Hamlet, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, he was a native of Richmond County, a graduate of Richmond Senior High School and a former member of the U.S. Army; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Bayless was a cadet of the North Carolina Highway Patrol; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Highway Patrol provides law enforcement on our state's highways; and

WHEREAS, on February 5, 1988, Cadet William E. Bayless, III died at Wake Medical Center in Raleigh, North Carolina as the result of injuries sustained in training to be a highway patrolman; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Highway Patrol and the citizens of Richmond County feel that it is important to keep alive the memory of this community-minded individual,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

That the bridge on N.C. 177 over the CSX Railroad in Hamlet, North Carolina be dedicated in honor of Cadet William E. Bayless, III.

That the N.C. Department of Transportation erect appropriate signs for such dedication.
