47 Approval - Designation of Overpass Bridge in the City of Wilson, the "Carl B. Renfro Bridge"

State Highway Administrator Willoughby presented for consideration a resolution from the Wilson City Council, whereby they requested the Commission's concurrence in the designation of the overpass bridge over the Seaboard Coast Line Railroad in the Hines-Wiggins Project as "Carl B. Renfro Bridge."

A motion was made by Commissioner Clark, seconded by Commissioner Dawkins, and unanimously carried, that the Commission concur in resolution from the Wilson City Council, in accordance with Mr. Willoughby's presentation.

Approval - Capital Improvement Requests - 1971-73 Budget

Chief Engineer Brinkley's request, a motion was made by Commissioner James Smith that the Commission approve the allocation of Capital Improvement Funds from the 1971-73 Budget to cover cost of the following items.
