- 2) Southern Dyestuff Company will participate in the construction costs required by Project 6.803493 to the extent of \$100,000 with said participation to be due and payable on July 1, 1973.
- 3) Upon completion of Project 6.803493, the portion of existing SR 1606 lying on the property of Southern Dyestuff Company is to be deleted from the State Highway System.

Therefore, a motion was made by Commissioner Maxwell, seconded by Commissioner Dedmon, and the vote was unanimous, that the Commission enter into an agreement with Southern Dyestuff Company, in accordance with Mr. Willoughby's recommendation.

Approval - Designation of NC Highway 56 between Louisburg and NC 58 the "Clifton L. Benson Highway"

State Highway Administrator Willoughby presented a resolution adopted by the Franklin County Board of Commissioners on November 6, 1972, relative to naming section of NC 56 between Louisburg and the Nash County line the "Clifton L. Benson Highway."

Commissioner Williams, however, recommended that the entire portion of NC 56 between Louisburg and NC 58 be designated the "Clifton L. Benson Highway."

Accordingly, a motion was made by Commissioner Lynwood Smith that portion of NC Highway 56 between Louisburg and NC 58 be named the "Clifton L. Benson Highway." The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams, and unanimously carried.
