

RESOLUTION FOR COLONEL THOMAS FEREBEE

WHEREAS, Colonel Thomas Ferebee is a native son of Davie County; and

WHEREAS, Colonel Thomas Ferebee served with distinction and honor in the United States Army during World War II; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation has recently constructed a new bridge across Hunting Creek on United States Highway 64 West in Davie County; and

WHEREAS, the Davie County Board of Commissioners and the Town of Mocksville Board of Commissioners requested the North Carolina Board of Transportation name this bridge in honor of Colonel Thomas Ferebee, a true hero.

Now, Therefore, Be IT Resolved:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation name the new bridge over Hunting Creek on United States Highway 64 West the *Colonel Thomas Ferebee Bridge*.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.
