A RESOLUTION FOR DAVID E. HENSON

WHEREAS, David E. Henson was born and reared in western North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, David E. Henson graduated from the School of Dentistry at the University of North Carolina in Chapel Hill in 1961 and has served the residents of Macon County as a dentist since then; and

WHEREAS, David E. Henson was elected to the Franklin Town Council in 1971 and was elected a Mayor in 1983; and

WHEREAS, David E. Henson was a member of the Local Government Commission for three years and was elected as Vice President of the League of Municipalities in October 1992; and

WHEREAS, the N.C. Department of Transportation has received individual requests from the members of the Franklin Town Council to honor Mayor Henson.

That the bridge carrying westbound traffic on U.S. 441 Business in Franklin over the Little Tennessee River be named the "David E. Henson Bridge" to honor him for his years of service to Macon County and Western North Carolina.
