

RESOLUTION FOR FOREST RANGER JOHN HOLLOWELL

Upon the recommendation of the Road Naming Committee, a motion was made by Board Member Fearing, seconded by Board Member Kernea, to approve the following resolution:

WHEREAS, John Wilbur Hollowell served as a Chowan County Deputy Forest Ranger/ex officio Game Warden with the Department of Conservation and Development beginning in January, 1929; and

WHEREAS, on August 30, 1930, Deputy Hollowell was assaulted by three individuals after testifying as a witness for the state when he left the courtroom, suffered a concussion, and later died that day; and

WHEREAS, the Chowan County Emergency Responder Memorial Committee and the Chowan County Board of Commissioners support the dedication of the bridge naming in honor and memory of Deputy Forest Ranger/ex officio Game Warden Deputy John Wilbur Hollowell.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation names the Rocky Hock Creek Bridge on Rocky Hock Road in Chowan County as the **Deputy John Hollowell Bridge**.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.
