WHEREAS, the Murfreesboro Town Council and the Hertford County Board of Commissioners passed resolutions requesting the North Carolina Department of Transportation to honor Dr. Walter Reed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation name the U.S. 158 Bypass of Murfreesboro the "Walter Reed Memorial Highway" in honor of this famous doctor whose accomplishments lead to a better and healthier state, nation and world.

That the North Carolina Department of Transportation erect appropriate signs at a suitable time.
