WHEREAS, Earl C. Davis has contributed to the economic prosperity of Carteret County through establishing and operating several businesses therein; and

WHEREAS, Earl C. Davis was instrumental in the development of over 600 acres of land on Harkers Island; and

WHEREAS, Earl C. Davis worked hard to help establish an out-patient clinic on Harkers Island; and

WHEREAS, his efforts played a vital role in the establishment of both the first bridge built that linked Harkers Island to the Mainland and also the current bridge.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:

1. The current bridge that links Harkers Island to the Mainland in Carteret County will be named the Earl C. Davis Memorial Bridge.

2. The Department of Transportation is ordered to erect appropriate signs at a suitable time.
