

RESOLUTION FOR GARLAND NEWMAN

WHEREAS, Garland Newman was a lifelong resident of the Union Hill Church Community of Surry County; and

WHEREAS, Garland Newman was a successful farmer, loyal and trusted citizen of the community and one of the founders of the Union Hill Monthly Meeting of the Friends Church; and

WHEREAS, the church is located adjacent to the new Interstate 74 in Surry County; and

WHEREAS, a substantial portion of the Newman farm including the Newman home place was needed for the Interstate 74 project; and

WHEREAS, the Surry County Board of Commissioners and many of the area residents have asked the N.C. Board of Transportation to honor Mr. Newman.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the N.C. Board of Transportation names the bridge on Red Brush Road over Interstate 74 the *Garland Newman Bridge* to honor Mr. Newman for his dedication and service to his community.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.

Adopted, this the second day of October 1998, by the North Carolina Board of Transportation.
