## RESOLUTION FOR GEORGE W. LILES

WHEREAS, George W. Liles has served the Cabarrus County community for many years, including eight years as Mayor of the City of Concord; and

WHEREAS, George W. Liles has worked constantly for the betterment of Cabarrus County's economic, cultural and aesthetic development; and

WHEREAS, George W. Liles has dedicated his life to improving the health of the citizens of Cabarrus County; and

WHEREAS, after he retired, George W. Liles demonstrated his deep and genuine love of the county's citizens by helping establish the Community Free Clinic; and

WHEREAS, the clinic provides free medical care for those Cabarrus County residents who are unable to afford proper medical assistance; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation is constructing a thoroughfare through Concord and part of Cabarrus County known as the Westside Bypass; and

WHEREAS, the Cabarrus County Board of Commissioners and the Concord City Council requested the North Carolina Board of Transportation name the Westside Bypass in honor of Mayor George W. Liles.

## Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation names the Westside Bypass from Interstate 85 in Cabarrus County to N.C. 49 in Concord the *George W. Liles Parkway* for his efforts and accomplishments on behalf of the citizens of Concord and Cabarrus County.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.
