

RESOLUTION FOR HECTOR MACLEAN

WHEREAS, Hector MacLean contributed greatly through governmental, civic and church-related activities to the city of Lumberton; and

WHEREAS, Hector MacLean dedicated his life to his community by serving as Mayor of the City of Lumberton and as a North Carolina State Senator; and

WHEREAS, Hector MacLean served as President and Chairman of the Board of Southern National Bank and Southern National Corporation, catapulting the bank into a major institution and enhancing the city's growth, economy and prestige; and

WHEREAS, Hector MacLean has been an active and tireless contributor to civic and political affairs in the community; and

WHEREAS, Hector MacLean played a critical role to ensure Interstate 95 extended into Lumberton and Robeson County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lumberton requested the North Carolina Board of Transportation to honor Hector MacLean.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation name the portion of Interstate 95, which travels through the city of Lumberton and Robeson County, the *Hector MacLean Highway*.

That appropriate sign be erected at a suitable time.
