WHEREAS, Herbert G. "Buddy" Phillips served with distinction as a member of the North Carolina State Highway Commission from 1961-1965; and

WHEREAS, Herbert G. "Buddy" Phillips was instrumental in securing bridges to both Emerald Isle and North Topsail Beach as well as other significant highway improvements; and

WHEREAS, Herbert G. "Buddy" Phillips lived for many years in Jacksonville and Onslow County as an upstanding and generous citizen whose philanthropic nature benefitted many; and

WHEREAS, the generosity of the Phillips family is evidenced by the donation of many pieces of real estate for community use, including Trinity Methodist Church, Infant of Prague Catholic Church, Northwoods Methodist Church, Phillips Park, Kerr Street Recreation Center, the Jacksonville Rescue Squad and adjacent City Park, and the property for the Chamber of Commerce; and

WHEREAS, Board of Transportation member Tommy Pollard fully supports the recognition of Herbert G. "Buddy" Phillips for his contributions to North Carolina.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the bridge across the New River on US-17 is hereby designated the "Herbert G. 'Buddy' Phillips Bridge."

2. That the N.C. Department of Transportation is ordered to erect signs at a suitable time.
