

RESOLUTION FOR ISAAC BROOKS

WHEREAS, Isaac Brooks was a citizen of Chatham County who served as one of the first representatives to the North Carolina General Assembly (1771-1773); and

WHEREAS, Isaac Brooks was instrumental in introducing and passing legislation which built a public road passing through Chatham County near the present location of U.S. 421; and

WHEREAS, U.S. 421 was the first four-lane highway extending through Chatham County; and


WHEREAS, the Siler City Board of Commissioners has asked the North Carolina Department of Transportation to honor Isaac Brooks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation name the section of U.S. 421 through Chatham County the *Isaac Brooks Highway* for his service and vision of transportation in Chatham County and the state of North Carolina.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.
