WHEREAS, Jake Alexander took a keen interest in ensuring that all citizens of North Carolina enjoy the best possible road system; and


WHEREAS, Jake Alexander held a firm belief that a good transportation network is the economic lifeblood of a state; and WHEREAS, Jake Alexander served big state.
