WHEREAS, Jake White dedicated his life to the benefit of others and service to mankind, not only within his community but throughout the entire county and region; and

WHEREAS, Jake White has given many years of unselfish contributions to his community, his family and his many friends and neighbors; and

WHEREAS, Jake White has served on the Appalachian Regional Commission, Caldwell County Planning Board and Caldwell County Farm Bureau, and

WHEREAS, Jake White was instrumental in the establishment of the Oak Hill Ruritan Club, Little River Fire Department, Oak Hill Community Park and Oak Hill Child Development Center, and

WHEREAS, the Caldwell County Board of Commissioners requested the North Carolina Department of Transportation honor Jake White.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation names U.S. 64/90 from Four Season Drive at Oak Hill to the Alexander/Caldwell County line the *Jake White Highway* for his outstanding service to his community, county and region.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.
