WHEREAS, Jake White has given many years of unselfish contributions to his community, his family and his many friends and neighbors; and

WHEREAS, Jake White has served on the Appalachian Regional Commission, Caldwell County Planning Board and Caldwell County Farm Bureau; and

WHEREAS, Jake White was instrumental in the establishment of the Oak Hill Ruritan Club, Little River Fire Department, Oak Hill Community Park and Oak Hill Child Development Center; and

WHEREAS, the Caldwell County Board of Commissioners requested the North Carolina Department of Transportation honor Jake White.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation names U.S. 64/90 from Four Season Drive at Oak Hill to the Alexander/Caldwell County line the *Jake White Highway* for his outstanding service to his community, county and region.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.
