Pursuant to request from the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners, and on a motion by Council Member Randall, which was seconded by Council Member Lackey, the Council (1) approved the naming of SR 1297 in Lincoln County THE

JERRY CRUMP ROAD and (2) directed the Division Engineer to have an appropriate sign erected on the road.

It was noted the late Mr. Crump was the youngest man to win the Congressional Medal of Honor.

1. Chairman Bradshaw introduced Charlie Shapard, Personnel Director. A discussion followed relative to temporary employees. It was noted the Personnel Policy mandates that no employee work more than 9 months consecutively on a temporary basis. Also, the importance of placing capable temporary employees in permanent positions, when possible, was emphasized.
