## RESOLUTION

Whereas, John Motley Morehead, III was born in Spray, North Carolina and attended the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, majoring in chemistry; and

Whereas, John Motley Morehead, III pioneered discovery in the uses of carbon dioxide, which resulted in the founding of one of Amnerica's great

industrial corportations -- the Union Carbide Company; and

Whereas, John Motley Morehead, III has, through his philanthropy, contributed the Bell Tower at Chapel Hill, a hospital in Eden, the planetarium in Chapel Hill and the establishment of the Morehead Scholarship program at UNC-CH, which have benefitted the citizens of North Carolina; and

Whereas, John Motley Morehead, III has made significant contributions

to the State of North Carolina; and

Whereas, a fitting honor for his contributions would be to name the section of Interstate 40 from NC-147 at the Research Triangle Park to US-15-501 at Chapel Hill:

Now, therefore, be it resolved as follows:

- 1. That I-40 from NC-147 at the Research Triangle Park to US-15-501 shall be designated the "John Motley Morehead, III Freeway."
- 2. That the Department of Transportation shall erect appropriate signs for the designation.
