RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE "JOSEPH M. BRYAN BOULEVARD"

WHEREAS, Joseph M. Bryan has made significant contributions to his community, state and fellow man by virtue of the following:

1. The "Joseph and Kathleen Bryan Research Building" at the Duke University Medical Center;
2. The "Joseph and Kathleen Bryan Communication Center" at the University of North Carolina Center for Public Television in Chapel Hill;
3. The "Kathleen Price and Joseph M. Bryan Scholarship and Fellowship in Business and Economics" at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro;
4. The "Joseph and Kathleen Bryan Living and Learning Center" at the North Carolina School of Science and Mathematics in Durham;
5. The "Joseph M. and Kathleen Price Bryan University Center" at Duke University;
6. The Bryan Enrichment Center for the City of Greensboro;
7. The "Bryan House" Headquarters for Development in University Relations at North Carolina A & T State University; and

WHEREAS, the generosity and philanthropy of Joseph B. Bryan has enriched the lives of many of his fellow citizens; and

WHEREAS, Joseph M. Bryan currently serves as a director and member of the Executive Committee of the Jefferson-Pilot Corporation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Greenville has endorsed the naming of the Benjamin Parkway Extension as the "Joseph M. Bryan Boulevard;" and

WHEREAS, Board of Transportation members Bill Buchanan and Ron Barbee support the designation:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the proposed Benjamin Parkway Connector from Northwest Greensboro to the Regional Airport is hereby designated the "Joseph M. Bryan Boulevard."
2. That the Department of Transportation erect appropriate signs for said designation.
