WHEREAS, the late Jullian Russell Allsbrook was a native of Roanoke Rapids in Halifax County, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Jullian Russell Allsbrook graduated from the Roanoke Rapids public schools and the University of North Carolina Law School where he was student body president; and

WHEREAS,, Jullian Russell Allsbrook was a member of the Halifax County, North Carolina and American bar associations, and the North Carolina and United States Supreme Court bars; and

WHEREAS,, Jullian Russell Allsbrook represented Halifax County in the North Carolina House of Representatives and served for many years in the North Carolina Senate; and

WHEREAS, Jullian Russell Allsbrook was registered in "Who's Who in the South" and the "National Register of Prominent Americans" and also served as Trustee of Chowan College; and


