## RESOLUTION FOR M.Q. PLUMBLEE

WHEREAS, the late M.Q. Plumblee was a respected citizen of Caswell County; and

WHEREAS, M.Q. Plumblee served his community and county as an educator, author and active civic leader; and

WHEREAS, M.Q. Plumblee was principal in the Caswell County Public Schools for forty years - from 1931-1961 at Anderson High School and from 1961-1971 at Bartlett Yancey High School; and

WHEREAS, M.Q. Plumblee authored <u>Heritage of Caswell County</u> and <u>From Rabbit Shuffle to Collings Hill</u>, two books about life in Caswell County; and

WHEREAS, the Caswell County Board of Commissioners in concurrence-with the Southern Caswell Ruritan Club of which M.Q. Plumblee was a charter member, formally adopted a resolution asking the North Carolina Board of Transportation to honor the late M.Q. Plumblee.

## Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation name the portion of North Carolina Highway 62 from the Caswell-Alamance County line to the corporate limits of Yanceyville the M.Q. Plumblee Memorial Highway for his service to Caswell County.

That the North Carolina Department of Transportation erect appropriate signs at a suitable time.
