

RESOLUTION MAYOR BILLY HILL

WHEREAS, the town of Murfreesboro is located on the Meherrin River in Hertford County; and

WHEREAS, United States Highway 258 crosses the Meherrin River as it enters Murfreesboro; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable William W. (Billy) Hill served the citizens of Hertford County for 43 years as Town Councilman, County Commissioner, Chairman of the County Commissioners and for the last 27 years as mayor of Murfreesboro; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Billy Hill was a well respected member of the community who showed compassion and wisdom in dealing with the citizens of Murfreesboro and Hertford County; and

WHEREAS, the community sustained a great loss at his death in December 1996; and

WHEREAS, the Murfreesboro Town Council adopted a resolution requesting the North Carolina Board of Transportation to honor Mayor Billy Hill.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation name the bridge over the Meherrin River on United States Highway 258 in Murfreesboro the *Mayor Billy Hill Bridge* for his long-time and dedicated service to his community.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.
