16 Designation of Bridge in Dare County as the "Melvin R. Daniels Bridge"

In accordance with request from the Dare County Board of Commissioners, as presented by State Highway Administrator Willoughby, a motion was made by Commissioner Gillam, seconded by Commissioner Nowell, and the vote was unanimous, that the Commission concur in the designation of Bridge No. 64-0540, located on US 64-264 between the Roanoke Sound Bridge and Whalebone Junction, as the "Melvin R. Daniels Bridge" and erect appropriate signs.

September 7, 1972 Meeting in Jacksonville

Commissioner Ellis advised the Members of the Commission that the next meeting will be on September 7th, in Jacksonville.

Action Re Placing Signs on Highway Right of Way

State Highway Administrator Willoughby advised that Secretary of Transportation Mills has requested the Commission to give consideration to the request made by the Thomasville Rescue Squad to place signs on highway right of way, which would give motorist information and directions to a free "snack bar - rest stop area" operated by the Rescue Squad during holidays. Administrator Willoughby noted the North Carolina General Statutes (G.S. 136-32) prohibits the placement of signs other than official signs on roads comprising a part of the State Highway System.

After some discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner Allen, seconded by Commissioner Ragsdale, and the vote was unanimous, that the request of the Thomasville Rescue Squad be denied and that letters be written to both the Thomasville Rescue Squad and the
