**WHEREAS**, Merle Dryman has been a long-time Macon County resident, civic and community leader; and

**WHEREAS**, Merle Dryman has contributed her time and personal resources to conservation and beautification projects in Macon County; and

**WHEREAS**, Merle Dryman has been particularly instrumental in developing and implementing beautification projects on and surrounding the Franklin Bypass; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin Bypass from Sanderstown Road on U.S. 441 North, to the end of the four lane on U.S. 64 West, is graced with large numbers of ornamental trees, shrubs and flowers, largely as a result of Mrs. Dryman's efforts, including her organizational skills and personal hard work; and


