
WHEREAS Odell Williamson has developed Ocean Isle Beach which has become the finest resort area on the East Coast, and

WHEREAS Odell Williamson through his efforts has contributed so much to the economy of Brunswick County and North Carolina by attracting millions of tourists, and


WHEREAS Odell Williamson has developed an area which is ideally suited for permanent residences, retirees and also vacationers;
