Approval – Resolution for Officer James R. Grayson

Upon a recommendation from the Road Naming Committee a motion was made by Board member Halsey, which was seconded by Board Member Wall to approve the following:

WHEREAS, Officer James R. Grayson was shot and killed in the line of duty on June 1, 1933 at the age of 22; and

WHEREAS, Officer James R. Grayson had been employed with the North Wilkesboro Police Department for two years before his untimely death; and

WHEREAS, Officer James R. Grayson is the only North Wilkesboro officer to lose his life in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, the Town of North Wilkesboro requested the North Carolina Department of Transportation honor Officer James R. Grayson for his service to the community and his ultimate sacrifice.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation name the bridge on U.S. 421 Business (West D Street) over the Reddies River in Wilkes County, as the **Officer James R. Grayson Bridge**.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.
