

RESOLUTION FOR TROOPER J.T. BROWN

WHEREAS, North Carolina State Highway Patrol Trooper J.T. Brown and his family moved to Lee County in November 1952; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Brown was a dedicated public servant who spent his career with the North Carolina State Highway Patrol keeping the highways safe for motorists who traveled in this state; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Brown was shot and killed in November 1957 after stopping a speeding motorist on U.S. 1 south of Sanford; and

WHEREAS, the Lee County Board of Commissioners requested the N.C. Department of Transportation honor Trooper Brown.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation name the bridge over Deep River on U.S. 1 north of Sanford in honor of North Carolina State Highway Patrol Trooper J.T. Brown who lost his life protecting the citizens of Lee County and all motorists who use the state's highways.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.
