WHEREAS, Reverend Carl Lackey was a well-know and respected citizen of Surry County; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Carl Lackey ministered to the citizens of Surry County for 43 years; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Carl Lackey lived in the church parsonage which was removed to build the bridge on U.S. 601 over the Interstate 77-U.S. 52 Connector; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors and members of White Plains Baptist Church requested that the new bridge on U.S. 601 be named in honor of Reverend Lackey; and


WHEREAS, the Surry County Board of Commissioners has formally requested the North Carolina Board of Transportation to name the bridge for Reverend Lackey.
