Concurrence in Request of Rockingham County Board of Commissioners to name Bridge on SR 1714 over Smith River in Eden in Honor of the late Reverend William J. Gordon

State Highway Administrator Willoughby presented a request from the Rockingham County Board of Commissioners to name bridge on SR 1714 over Smith River in Eden in honor of the late Reverend William J. Gordon, and recommended Commission concurrence in this request. He noted the matter has been held in abeyance since the October 5, 1972 Commission Meeting pending additional information.

After a discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner James Smith, seconded by Commissioner Williams, and the vote

was unanimous, that bridge located on SR 1714 over Smith River in Eden be named in honor of the late Reverend William J. Gordon.
