A motion was made by Board Member Harris, seconded by Board Member Daniels, and the vote was unanimous to approve the revised thoroughfare plan as recommended.

## Approval - Contract Maintenance Retreatment Program

Administrator Rose reviewed projects in Divisions 3, 5, 6, 7, 10, 11 and 13 and recommended they be added to the Contract Maintenance Retreatment Program.

Pursuant to his recommendation, a motion was made by Board Member Dean, seconded by Board Member Gallaher, and the vote was unanimous to add projects as outlined to the Contract Maintenance Retreatment Program. (Due to the length of this item, these projects are made a part of the record of this meeting and filed as an addendum to Minute Book 16.)

Approval - Continuation of Subscription to the "Research Correlation Service", July 1, 1983 - June 30, 1984

Pursuant to the recommendation of Administrator Rose, a motion was made by Board Member Daniels, seconded by Board Member Davis, and the vote was unanimous to approve continuation of subscription to the Research Correlation Service for Fiscal Year 1983-84 and authorize the State Highway Administrator to execute the agreement in behalf of the North Carolina Department of Transportation. Funds for this agreement will come from the Highway Planning and Research Program established under the Federal-aid Highway Act.

Approval - Naming of Bridge on SR 1127 over Snowbird Creek in Graham County the "Richard and Nettie Parrette Bridge"

Administrator Rose noted the Department has received a request

and resolution from the Graham County Board of Commissioners to name the bridge on SR 1127 over Snowbird Creek in honor of Doctors Richard and Nettie Parrette for their many years of dedication and service to the people of Graham County. He recommended approval of the request.

A motion was made by Board Member Davis, seconded by Board Member Harper, and the vote was unanimous to name the bridge on SR 1127 over Snowbird Creek in Graham County the "RICHARD AND NETTIE PARRETTE BRIDGE" and authorize the Department to erect appropriate signs.

Approval - Delegation of Authority Covering Award of Certain Contracts Required for Implementation of the East West Freeway in Durham - Projects 8.1414602, 8.1414603, 9.8059015, U-77

Pursuant to the recommendation of Administrator Rose, the following resolution was unanimously approved upon a motion by Board Member Burnette which was seconded by Board Member Harris:

"WHEREAS, the municipal agreement between the Department of Transportation and the City of Durham covering Projects 8.1414602, 8.1414603 and 9.8059015 provides for State and Federal participation in the costs of work to be performed by the parties in conjunction with the relocation of the Crest Street Community;

WHEREAS, the municipal agreement provides for the Department of Transportation to be responsible for letting certain contracts involved in the relocation of Crest Street Community, including demolition of building contracts, housemoving contracts and house construction contracts;

WHEREAS, formal Board action awarding each contract to be let may cause unnecessary delay in awarding said contracts;
