WHEREAS, S. Thomas Rhodes is a native of New Hanover County and received his early education in the public school system of Wilmington; and

WHEREAS, S. Thomas Rhodes completed undergraduate studies at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and received a masters degree from Auburn University; and

WHEREAS, S. Thomas Rhodes was elected to the North Carolina House of Representatives; and

WHEREAS, S. Thomas Rhodes served the citizens of Wilmington for over sixteen years and was active in numerous civic organizations; and

WHEREAS, S. Thomas Rhodes worked on behalf of the citizens of North Carolina and served as Secretary of the Department of Natural Resources and Community Development, as a member of the North Carolina Board of Transporatation and as Deputy Secretary of the North Carolina Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, S. Thomas Rhodes during his tenure worked to ensure the citizens of New Hanover County and the surrounding counties received a fare share of limited government resources which included the funding for several bridges over the Cape Fear River; and

WHEREAS, the New Hanover County Board of Commissioners honored S. Thomas Rhodes for his services to the state and the community in a resolution passed unanimously on October 5, 1992.
