

RESOLUTION FOR SENATOR AARON W. PLYLER

WHEREAS, Senator Aaron W. Plyler was born in Union County October 1, 1926, to Isom F. and Ida Foard Plyler; and

WHEREAS, Senator Aaron W. Plyler attended Benton Heights School and Florida Military Academy; and

WHEREAS, Senator Aaron W. Plyler served as a member of the North Carolina House of Representatives from 1974-1982 and as a member of the North Carolina Senate from 1982 to present; and

WHEREAS, Senator Aaron W. Plyler serves as chair of the Senate Appropriations/Base Budget Committee and is a member of the Senate Transportation, Pensions and Retirement, Base Budget, Redistricting, and Ways and Means committees; and

WHEREAS, Senator Aaron W. Plyler has represented the citizens of Monroe, Union County and the entire 17th Senatorial District of North Carolina with distinction; and

WHEREAS, Senator Aaron W. Plyler is known as a "True Southern Gentleman" by the citizens of Monroe and Union County; and

WHEREAS, the Union County Board of Commissioners, the Monroe City Council and the towns of Fairview and Unionville asked the North Carolina Department of Transportation to honor Senator Aaron W. Plyler.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation names U.S. 601 in Union County from the Cabarrus County line to U.S. 74 the *Senator Aaron W. Plyler Highway* for his many years of hard work and dedication that has led to a better way of life for the citizens of Monroe, Union County and the State of North Carolina.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.
