11 Approval - Designation of Bridge connecting the Towns of Spencer and East Spencer the "T. Roy Burdette, Jr., Bridge"

State Highway Administrator Willoughby submitted for consideration a request from the Aldermen of the Town Board of Spencer to name bridge connecting the Towns of Spencer and East Spencer the "T. Roy Burdette, Jr., Bridge."

Accordingly, a motion was made by Commissioner Dodson, seconded by Commissioner Gillam, and the vote was unanimous, that the Commission concur in request to name bridge on Jefferson Street, which connects the Towns of Spencer and East Spencer, the "T. Roy Burdette, Jr., Bridge."

Approval - Agreement with Southern Dyestuff Company covering Project 6.803493, Mecklenburg County

State Highway Administrator Willoughby advised the Highway Commission, at its meeting on February 3, 1972, approved as a part of the Statewide Secondary Program the relocation of a portion of SR 1606, Mecklenburg County, in the vicinity of the Southern Dyestuff Company property. He further advised discussions have been held with officials of the Southern Dyestuff Company, and recommended that the Commission enter into an agreement with Southern Dyestuff Company, stipulating the following provisions in connection with Project 6.803493:

- 1) Southern Dyestuff Company will convey to the Highway Commission without cost the necessary right-of-way and construction easements for the portion of Project 6.803493 crossing their property.
