Approval - Naming US 421 Bypass Around the Wilkesboros "The Watson Brame Expressway"

Public Information Officer Laney advised the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of North Wilkesboro adopted a resolution on October 28, 1970, requesting the State Highway Commission to name the US 421 Bypass around the Wilkesboros "The Watson Brame Expressway" in honor of former Highway Commissioner Watson Brame for his faithful service.
