Approval - Naming of New Bridge on US 19 Over Little Tennessee River in Swain County the "Thomas A. Sandlin Memorial Bridge"

Administrator Rose noted the Department has received from the Swain County Board of Commissioners a request to name the new bridge on US 19 over the Little Tennessee River in honor of Mr. Thomas A. Sandlin. He recommended the board approve the request.

A motion was made by Board Member Davis, seconded by Board Members Ponder and Daniels, and the vote was unanimous to approve the name "Thomas A. Sandlin Memorial Bridge" for the new bridge on US 19 over the Little Tennessee River in Swain County and authorize the Department to erect appropriate signs.

Board Member Davis expressed appreciation to the board for approving the naming of this bridge in honor of Mr. Sandlin, noting that he felt the honor was much deserved as Mr. Sandlin worked for development and progress of Swain County for most of his life, serving as a member of the Highway Patrol for some thirty-five years as well as a member of the Highway Commission in 1972.

Approval - Concurrence in Award of Contract with City of Durham

Pursuant to the recommendation of Administrator Rose, a motion was made by Board Member Dean, seconded by Board Member Hamme, and the vote was unanimous to concur with the City of Durham in the award of the contract on Project 8.14146Q3, Phase II Street Construction for the Crest Street Neighborhood, to Nello L. Teer Company in the amount of \$341,360.55. Funding for this project is 37.6% City and 62.4% State and Federal-aid funds.

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Approval - Concurrence in Award of Contract with City of Durham

Pursuant to the recommendation of Administrator Rose, a motion was made by Board Member Dean, seconded by Board Member Hamme, and the vote was unanimous to concur with the City of Durham in the award of the contract on Project 8.1414603, Phase II Street Construction for the Crest Street Neighborhood, to Nello L. Teer Company in the amount of \$341,360.55. Funding for this project is 37.6% City and 62.4% State and Federal-aid funds.
