

RESOLUTION FOR THREE GOVERNORS BRIDGE

WHEREAS, the bridge on the U.S. 70 Bypass of Haw River in Alamance County carries traffic over the Haw River; and

WHEREAS, three of North Carolina governors were from Haw River; and

WHEREAS, Governors Thomas Michael Holt, William Kerr Scott and Robert W. Scott were instrumental in improving transportation in North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the Haw River Historical Association has recommended that the bridge over the Haw River on the U.S. 70 Bypass in Alamance County be named the Three Governors Bridge; and

WHEREAS, the Haw River Town Council has requested the North Carolina Department of Transportation honor the town's three governors.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation names the bridge over the Haw River on the U.S. 70 Bypass in Alamance County the *Three Governors Bridge* to honor Governors Thomas Michael Holt, William Kerr Scott and Robert W. Scott for their commitment to transportation and their contribution to the citizens of Haw River, Alamance County and the state of North Carolina.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.
