

RESOLUTION FOR TROOPER CALVIN E. TAYLOR

WHEREAS, Trooper Calvin E. Taylor was born May 4, 1960, in Asheville in Buncombe County, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Calvin E. Taylor graduated from Pisgah Senior High School in Haywood County; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Calvin E. Taylor was sworn in as a member of the North Carolina State Highway Patrol on August 1, 1981, and was assigned to Burnsville in Yancey County; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Calvin E. Taylor was transferred to Canton in Haywood County on September 20, 1993, and

WHEREAS, Trooper Calvin E. Taylor was killed October 3, 2001, during a traffic stop on westbound Interstate 40 between mile marker 29 and mile marker 30 in Haywood County; and

WHEREAS, the Haywood County Board of Commissioners requested the North Carolina Department of Transportation honor Trooper Calvin E. Taylor.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved:

That the North Carolina Board of Transportation names the bridge on Secondary Road 1610 over Interstate 40 in Haywood County the *Trooper Calvin E. Taylor Memorial Bridge* for his outstanding service and dedication to the citizens of his community, region and state.

That appropriate signs be erected at a suitable time.
